
President's Message

You will need good tires, chains or cables, gloves, pliers, and kitty litter for icy roads. Check your fluids and make sure they are for low temperature; you will want a clear windshield, and don't forget the windshield scrappers. Always carry water, snacks, warm blankets, t/p and plastic bags in case nature calls and you are stuck on the road. Review your rules for driving on icy roads, downshift to slow down when possible, braking can cause a skid, oops, and turn into the skid. Turn on your 4 wheel drive or your car's rendition once the road starts to get slick. And, make sure you have a full tank of gas.


