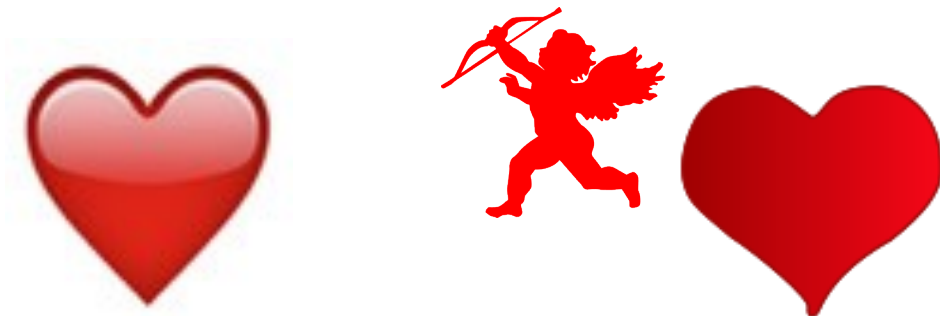
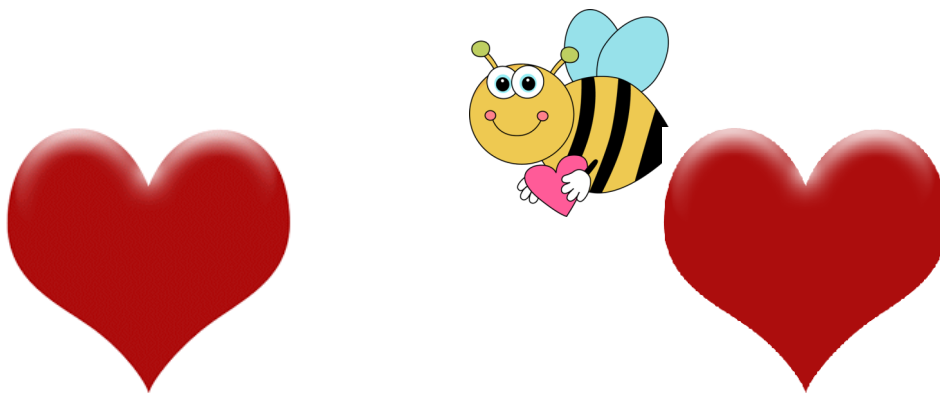

Have a safe and exciting snow season!!

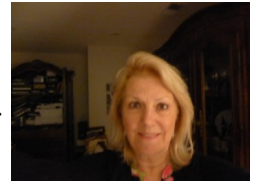
