

North American FWSA Ski Week - 2021 Sun Valley, Idaho



January 30 - February 6, 2021

Sun Valley Ski Resort was selected as the destination for the Annual 2021 Far West Ski Association Ski Week. Sun Valley has more than 3,400 vertical feet and over 2,000 acres of varied terrain on two mountains. Bald Mountain's consistent pitch, lack of lift lines, and variety of terrain have earned it the reputation as one of the world's best ski mountains. Sun Valley is known for their snowmaking and groomed runs. They have snowmaking on 646 acres and groomed runs on 810 acres.

Mountain Statistics:

- 2,154 skiable acres & increasing Bald Mountain by 380 acres for 2020- 2021
- More than 3,400 vertical feet
- 121 trails and 30 acres of glade skiing & boarding terrain
- 18 lifts
- Longest run is 3 miles


