

DAY 1 Depart the USA: Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

DAY 6 Pinhão — Vega de Terrón: Begin the day with a visit to the beautiful 18th-century estate of Quinta do Tedo Vineyard with spectacular views of the Douro Valley.
