

Far West to Celebrate 90th Birthday in San Francisco: Our Association was founded in a lunchtime meeting in the Palace Hotel on October 7, 1930. We're going back on October 10, 2020. In coordination with the staff at the Palace, we're planning a luncheon for 50 stalwart skiers to commemorate our origins. The historic evolution of the Association from the birth of skiing as sport in the gold camps to today's multistate organization with ten councils will be recounted by expert witnesses to its accomplishments. Invitations will be sent out in the summer of 2020 to persons on this list. Seating will be limited.

In the earliest days of the gold rush, Wells Fargo was founded and the miners in Plumas County entertained themselves in winters with match races on long-boards made locally. The first "formal" race was in 1861 and longboard racing continues to this day, including a world championship. The legacy of this early organization of skiing is a basis for the Association. That legacy includes the creation of ski clubs, league racing (organized by the historic Alturas Snowshoe Club), and the advance from necessities for mobility and transportation to skiing as a sport, all of which were "firsts" in North America.
