Events are on hold for this month as well, but when we can we will gather to celebrate.



The ski season was shut down early last year because of the Corona virus. This is the **present** plan for the ski areas.

All Tahoe Epic pass resorts require reservations.

Face coverings will be required at all ski areas in all common areas.

Buying a lift ticket or booking ski lessons will need to be done online for almost all resorts..

Some resorts will require reservations even for season passholders.

Some will limit capacity on the mountain and indoors.

Lifts will be loaded with groups that came together so don't lose your friends going down the hill.

There will be almost no indoor eating anywhere, at this time, so dress warm.

Squaw Valley

Opening date: Nov 25th

Buy ticket ahead of time. Check their requirements if you have an Ikon pass.

Some food available for online orders for takeout.

Alpine Meadows

Opening date: Nov 25th

Buy ticket ahead of time. Check their requirements if you have an Ikon pass.

Some food available for online orders for eating outside.

Free shuttle in the resort area

Sugar Bowl

Opening date: Thanksgiving weekend

Gondola from Village lodge will be available for groups

Buy ticket ahead of time online only.

Food available for online orders for eating outside.

Free shuttle in the resort area

Boreal

Opening date: Nov 23rd

Buy ticket ahead of time online only or have a season pass.

Temperature checks before going to inside facilities.

Homewood

Opening date: Dec 11th

Buy ticket ahead of time online only and get a reservation for parking. Season passes are almost sold out.

No group lessons this year.

Food available at the West Shore Cafe for eating outside.

Northstar

Opening date: Nov 20th for Epic pass holders. All resorts on the Epic pass require reservations.

Day lift tickets on sale online after Dec 8th. Reservations required.

Group and private lessons lessons available.

Food options note only that you should buy food for lunch on the way (or pack your own).

Heavenly

Opening date: Nov 20th for Epic pass holders. All resorts on the Epic pass require reservations.

Day lift tickets on sale online after Dec 8th. Reservations required.

California side will open first. Gondola operation for skiers may be delayed.

Group and private lessons lessons available.

Food will be available for pickup at the California base side restaurants.

Kirkwood

Opening date: Dec 4th for Epic pass holders. All resorts on the Epic pass require reservations. Day lift tickets on sale online after Dec 8th. Reservations required.

Sierra at Tahoe

Opening date: to be determined No reservations required at this time.

Lifts will be loaded with groups that came together.

If capacity allows day-of-lift tickets will be sold but better to buy them online ahead of time Food will be available to eat on the outdoor deck at the bottom of West Bowl.

Diamond Peak

Opening date: Dec 10th

Reservations for season passholders not required at this time.

Buy day passes online ahead of time. Lift tickets were \$60 for over age 65 and \$29 for over age 70 (as I recall, present day prices are not yet available)

Free area shuttle.

Mid-mountain Snowflake lodge has an enormous outside deck.

Mt Rose

Opening date: as soon as possible (late November) but early season access limited to season passholders only.

No day-of ticket sales.

Lifts will be loaded with groups that came together.

Book ski or snow board lessons ahead of time.

Mammoth Mountain

Open

Reservations not presently required for Ikon pass holders

Buy ticket ahead of time. Day ticket prices \$79.

Gondolas Lifts will be loaded with groups that came together and windows will stay open.

Private lessons only for individuals and groups


We are still taking signups for Bali in 2022, May 15-26. We already have 30 with deposits in so we have room for a few more.


