

Portugal and the Douro River Cruise





DAY 1 Depart the USA: Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal.



Regal splendor abounds in the Plaza Mayor, the heartbeat of the city. Visit the market and taste the local products including cheese, olives and bread. You'll have free time for lunch and to explore independently before returning to the ship in Portugal.
