# Presidents Message



## OUR HALL OF FAME

Some of our newer and even some of our older members may not know or remember the plethora of awards CVSC has garnered at the FWSA level. The Far West Ski Association published a lengthy history of the many Awards that are presented annually at the convention, held in June. These noteworthy presentations go back to the early 1960s and Castro Valley has been recognized frequently. I'll share with you the names I recognize and may sadly not recognize winners who have departed the club prior to 1993, when I joined. Awards are named for men and women with distinguished accomplishments and long term contribution to skiing.

The Hans George award is given to an individual who has contributed significant achievements to skiing reflecting long term contributions over the years. **Tucker Hoffmann** received this award in 2003.

The Elizabeth "Schatzi" Wood award is given to the Far West woman who has, through efforts in ski club, council, region, national or international activities, made a decisive contribution to skiing during either the past two years or in a prior year. In 1991 **Karen Kimball** was the recipient followed by **Kathy Hoffmann** in 1994

The J. Stanley Mullin Award is presented to a male member with the same qualifications as mentioned for the woman. In the year 1999 **Tucker Hoffmann** was recognized for this award

The Jordan Reily award went to **Karen Kimball** in 1995 for her activity and achievements in the Association's Public Affairs programs.

The President's award is given to the individual who the President of far west feels has done the most to advance the immediate goals of the Association during the previous year. **Kathy Hoffmann** along with Michael German and Steve Coxen were the winners of this impressive award in 2006.

Council Man and Woman of the Year. **Tucker Hoffmann** in 1994 and **Kathy Hoffmann** in 1997, chosen by their peers based on contributions to organized skiing.

In the beginning, this contest was mostly a beauty pageant for the ladies where the contestants modeled ski apparel. There were rounds of cocktail parties, publicity photos, tours and more parties. The winner was crowned Queen. In

1975 the Bay area entered a man and he was proclaimed King. In 1981 the contest was not held because Far West thought the contest was too sexist. The contest reappeared the following year as the "Council Man and Woman of the Year", the format used today.

And finally, The Joe Ross award—the club champion of the "qualifier" GS race at the annual Far West Ski Week, won by **Castro Valley** five years in a row, 1996 through 2000, and again in 2006 and 2007

Castro Valley Ski Club has much to be proud of and much to live up to. The names you see above in bold have really made a big difference in the quality of both the Far West and CVSC. Thanks ladies and gentleman for giving us the bragging rights for certainly three of the most honored members of this wonderful family we call Castro Valley. Your recognition is well deserved.
