A Word from our VP

and the deadline for submission this year was March 20.

This month I will discuss the fourth, the Charity and Community Service Special award. The intent of this recognition program is to encourage charity and community service involvement in all our FWSA councils and clubs and to recognize a club or council for its outstanding financial and/or volunteer support to one or more charitable organizations. All clubs and councils that apply will be recognized at the FWSA Convention. The three top clubs and one council will be selected to prepare a picture display board to be presented at the Convention. Any Far West Club or Council can apply for this recognition. Entries are judged on number of charity events, member participation, time involved, benefit to charity, event location and picture boards. The First place club will receive \$300 for the charity of their choice. Second and Third place will receive \$100 for their charity.

Statement for need to amend the CVSC by-laws

At one time in the history of the Castro Valley Ski Club, there was a strong racing team and the need for a dedicated position to support and meet the lodging needs of racers in the Lake Tahoe area: That position was entitled *V.P. of Weekend Activities*. But over the years, ski clubs all over the bay area have found that skiers who have raced are saying "been there- done that", and do not need to do it anymore. Castro Valley Ski Club was not immune to that sentiment. In addition, new recruits for the racing team are not forthcoming.

Particularly over the past two year or longer the position for V.P of Weekend Activities has not had any need to fulfill its duties. The condo in Tahoe that the racers have used has not been rented for that purpose in two years. Prior to that time, not all race weekends needed rental units to house racers.

But the need for a liaison to stay in contact with the owners of rental cabins and condos in the Tahoe area is still a useful activity.

It also became obvious that the Activity Chair was fulfilling the coordinating activities of many of the club's weekend activities. It became clear that there was some overlap and the potential to merge the current relevant activities of the VP of Weekend Activities and the Activities Chair into one position entitled VP of Club Activities. This position would replace the VP of Weekend Activities and eliminate the Activity Chair position and would be an elected position.

This is the proposal of the Board to the general membership of the Castro Valley Ski Club. Please see the accompanying pages showing the current bylaws and the proposed bylaw changes.

ARTICLE V: OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

Section 5.1: The Executive Board shall consist of the following elected officers:

Section 7.5 The Vice President of Weekend Trips shall;

Arrange lodging, collect fees, and assign beds for all race-weekend sponsored snow ski trips.

Get signed releases from all participants, and maintain a file on all releases.

Give receipts and Article IX information to all participants on weekend trips.

Turn in a financial report and all collected fees to the Treasurer for each weekend snow trip.

Assign a condo box captain for the weekend trips, who will serve for the entire ski season.






