### **Some information on Sightseeing at Jackson Hole**

Jackson Hole and the surrounding areas offer some of the most amazing scenic vistas and wildlife viewing. During winter, peace and serenity of snow covered fields, hills, and mountains make for magnificent vistas and scenery.

**Yellowstone National Park** is open to snowcoaches and snowmobiles. Once in the park, be sure to take the time to walk around one of the guided areas such as West Thumb Geyser Basin.

**Grand Teton National Park** has reduced automobile access in the winter. The inner road from the Taggart Lake trail head, north of Moose, to the Jackson Lake Dam is closed during the winter. Access to these areas requires snowshoes or cross-country skis. The outer road still provides great views of the range during the winter.
