A Word from our VP

This month I want to elaborate a bit on the new setup we have developed for obtaining clothing and other items with the CVSC logo, from Land's End. I have already provided details (June '14 issue) on specifying the logo you want (#1361418W), in the colors you specify, and on the URL you type into your browser (www.landsend.com/

business), or 800-338-2000, to look over the wares available.

Now I would like to acquaint you with other money saving aspects of doing business with Land's End. Because I set up the arrangement with them, I have been in on the receiving end of emails describing promotions. These promotions are special to their business with organizations that have established logos with them.

The promotions I've seen include special discounts on particular clothing items and on the logos as well. For example, logos are added free of charge for a specified time period. This would be a good time to load up if you have several items you would like to have identified.

It would be impractical for me to notify everyone about these promotions, the content and time limitations. The whole point of the Land's End setup is to enable you to define what you want, sort of a "demand pull" arrangement. In the past, the club has purchased ball caps, drink glasses, pennants, and the like with logos, and then made them available, sort of a "supply push" arrangement, hoping for demand to materialize. Sometimes this didn't happen. So the club is now out of the business of maintaining an inventory. Instead, we have arranged to meet any needs through a vendor, Land's End, which maintains our logo. Other ski clubs have done this to good effect.

So, if you're not interested, do nothing. The last thing I would do is give them your email address for new spam.

If you are, go to the web site and ask for the promotional emails for logo customers. If you have trouble with this, I'll help. The last time I went there, the email request popped up automatically. You should be able to stop and restart these emails at your discretion.




