This year the Race Committee meets in early October. Any surprises that come out of the meeting will be forwarded to potential racers early thereafter. The point system should stay basically the same as last year. I write “basically” because I never quite understood the system we are now using. Nevertheless, first place finishers can earn 25 points, but only if you finish within your handicap. And if you just finish the race you get 1 point. **I can still remember going through an entire race season without earning a single point.**
