

Well, the race schedule for the upcoming season is updated! And with weather unpredictable it could change, but for now, here it is.

This year the Race Committee meets in early October. Any surprises that come out of the meeting will be forwarded to potential racers early thereafter. The point system should stay basically the same as last year. I write

"basically" because I never quite understood the system we are now using. Nevertheless, first place finishers can earn 25 points, but only if you finish within your handicap. And if you just finish the race you get 1 point. I can still remember going through an entire race season without earning a single point.

Top Ten Reasons to Sign up for Racing:

Discounts on lift tickets on race day - \$20-\$40. Meet other skiers/boarders with similar ability. Tour the mountain with your new friends. Practice your snow skills by running the race course. Compete to win awards at each race. Compete to win prestigious awards at the end of the season. Qualify to represent your team or league at the end-of-season races. Get a great parking spot by arriving early for registration. A reason to ski/board in potentially miserable weather. Find out that mildly, miserable weather makes for the best skiing days.
